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e.g. only insure, sugar, Russian, passion, and in a few other words

[dʒ]: *J is always pronounced as [dʒ];*

e.g. Japanese

g is usually pronounced as [dʒ] before e or i

e.g. German, giraffe

but is pronounced as [g] before all other consonants;

e.g. gate, goodbye,

and sometimes before e and i,

e.g. get, give, etc.
